### Distance Learning Help Sheet – QR Codes and J2E

#### Logging on to J2E (Just2easy)

Your teacher will have shared a QR code in your child's Class Dojo portfolio which acts as your child's login to their school j2e account. It will look like this:

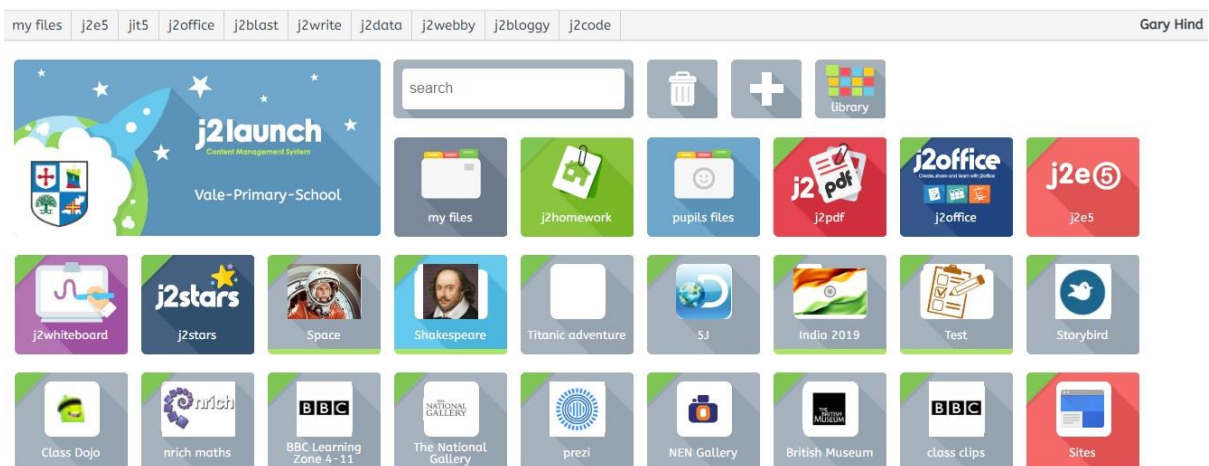


You can use a phone, a tablet or webcam to scan the QR code (picture) and it will log you straight in to your child's j2e account! Some phones and tablets will scan using the camera app. For others you may need to download a QR code reader app - there are lots of free ones to choose from.

Or, you can manually login to your child's account using any device such as a laptop or computer. Simply go to [j2e.com](http://j2e.com), use the Google option from the drop down list next to where it says 'network users' then children can login by typing in their username and password.

Children's usernames are usually their first name initial and surname followed by [vlps.sch.gg](http://vlps.sch.gg). For example, Joseph Bloggs username would be [jbloggs@vlps.sch.gg](mailto:jbloggs@vlps.sch.gg). Children's passwords are usually Password01 (the word password with a capital P and zero one). If 'Password01' doesn't work, try the word 'password' without the apostrophe's.

Once logged in successfully, you should see something like this, with your child's name in the top right hand corner.



Children can access their distance learning through accessing 'my files' but teachers will also guide their respective children and classes to tasks and activities they would like them to complete.

This will be done through a combination of Class Dojo, j2e and Google Drive. Remember, if you get stuck or cannot access any of the above, please contact school and we will be happy to help!
